The meeting of the National Center For Research Resources Comparative Medicine Review Committee was open to the public from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. on February 7, 2002, at the Four Points by Sheraton, Bethesda, MD.

CLOSED MEETING

The meeting of the National Center For Research Resources Comparative Medicine Review Committee was convened on February 7, 2002, at 8:00 a.m., at the Four Points by Sheraton, Bethesda, MD. John K. Critser, Ph.D. presided as chair. The roster includes all members of the committee. Others in attendance are either listed on the roster or visitor log.

This meeting was closed to the public in accordance with the determination that it was concerned with matters exempt from mandatory disclosure under Sections 552b(c)(4) and 552b(c)(6), Title 5, U.S. Code and Section 10(d) of the Federal Advisory Committee Act, as amended (5 U.S.C. Appendix 2). The Scientific Review Administrator explained policies and procedures regarding avoidance of conflict of interest situations; voting and priority ratings; and confidentiality of application materials, committee discussions, and recommendations.

Committee members absented themselves from the meeting during discussion of, and voting on, applications from their own institutions, or other applications in which there was a potential conflict of interest, real or apparent.

- 2 Institutional National Research Service Award applications requesting \$2,885,298 in support.
- 3 Midcareer Investigator Award in Biomedical and Behavioral Research applications requesting \$1,878,418 in support.
- 2 NRSA Short-Term Research Training applications requesting \$480,055 in support.
- 9 Research Project applications requesting \$11,115,945 in support.

3 Research Scientist Development Award - Research & Training applications requesting \$1,673,166 in support.
18 Resource-Related Research Projects applications requesting \$28,238,024 in support.
