CLOSED MEETING

The meeting of the National Center For Research Resources Special Emphasis Panel ZRR1 CM-3 01, Comparative Medicine was convened on February 5, 2003, at 10:00 a.m., at the Gaithersburg Marriott Washingtonian Center, Gaithersburg, MD. K.C. Kent Lloyd, D.V.M., Ph.D. presided as chair. The roster includes all members of the panel. Others in attendance are either listed on the roster or visitor log.

5 Research Project applications requesting \$8,044,447 in support.
